The Silviculture Forester will be responsible for the execution of Wild + Pine's annual forestry operations. This will require a blend of in-office and travel time to meet the needs of our clients, contractors, and seasonal staff / labour crews. In this role, a successful candidate will provide a level of leadership and management that allows them to have a balance of time in the office and in the field. As a Silviculture Forester at Wild + Pine you can expect 50% of your time will be in the field during the summer months and 10% of your time during the winter, returning home at the end of the day or shift.

The Silviculture Forester will report to Wild + Pine's Director of Projects, while working alongside each team member to execute projects across our operating landscape. Your dedicated contributions across our business lines will help define our future success in helping Canada become a leader in sustainability.

ROLES / RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Lead all aspects of Wild + Pine's afforestation, reforestation, land maintenance, and restoration efforts.
- Coordinate all office, planning, and field related work including contractor management, client and stakeholder interactions, data collection, GIS & mapping, record keeping/reporting, and project development activities required for the planning and implementation of annual silviculture activities.
- Preparation of project proposals, operational plans, safety documentation, progress and final reports, and budgets.

- Manage and supervise junior and seasonal staff members.
- Prepare supporting documentation for proposals and reports.
- Operational program refinement and development.
- Provide leadership in safety and environmental stewardship.

- Post-secondary degree or diploma in Forestry or related Natural Resource Management discipline.
- Minimum 3 – 5 years of prior experience in developing and executing silviculture programs in a project management or leadership role.
- Basic understanding of GIS and mapping applications.
- Strong work ethic, with a steep learning curve.
- The ability to work challenging and extended hours under varying weather conditions with a willingness to travel during the field season.
- Excellent computer skills with a strong attention to detail.
- Effective inter-personal communications and scientific writing skills.
- Hold, or be eligible for, a professional designation under your discipline.
